A few weeks ago, I breathed a sigh of relief. We'd completed the last lesson in catechism class, and I didn't need to head down to St. John School on Tuesday and Thursday mornings any longer. A week later, I breathed another sigh of relief. The public school class wrapped things up, had their year-end pizza party, and met one last time for a final review before "examination Sunday." A couple weekends ago, the eighth graders breathed their own sigh of relief – two of the girls even gave each other fist-bumps – after I asked the final review question! Last weekend, the six eighth-grade confirmands breathed sighs of relief. It was real! They'd celebrated Holy Communion for the first time without making the "yucky face" that they'd imagined. The confirmation certificates were signed, sealed, and delivered. Just a few days ago, I helped the St. John students and teachers close out the year with a service of thanks and praise to God. (I love leading chapel devotions together with those kids! But man alive – sometimes coming up with an attention-grabbing children's message is more stressful than writing and delivering a regular Sunday sermon! A sigh of relief was definitely in order.)

Of course, after finishing up those catechism classes and chapel devotions, it so happens that other things quickly get added to the schedule to take their place. Confirmation and graduation from eighth grade are certainly not the be-all and end-all. There's lots more to come. High school – or the next grade in school – is only a few short months away. For us adults, our employers probably don't give us a three-month break from the job. Life goes on as usual.

Although summer allows many of us to take a mental "sigh of relief" because the schedule changes up a bit, there's one area where we dare not become lax. Because my sinful nature doesn't take a single day off – because the devil and the sinful world around me are relentless in their attacks and temptations – I dare not take relief from the power source God's provided for me and my faith. I dare not unplug from Scripture.
